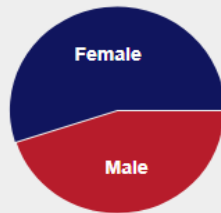

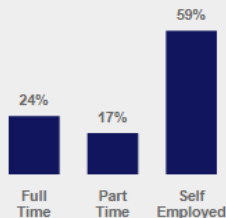

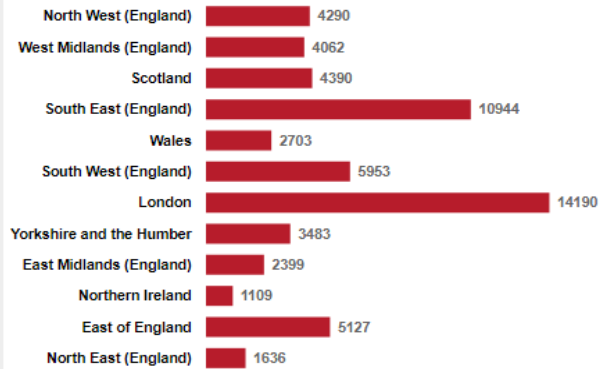
Gender Split



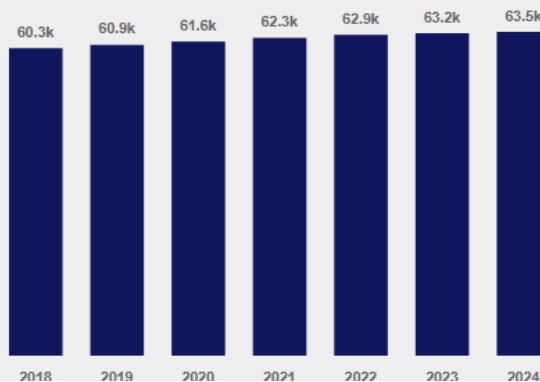
Employment Status

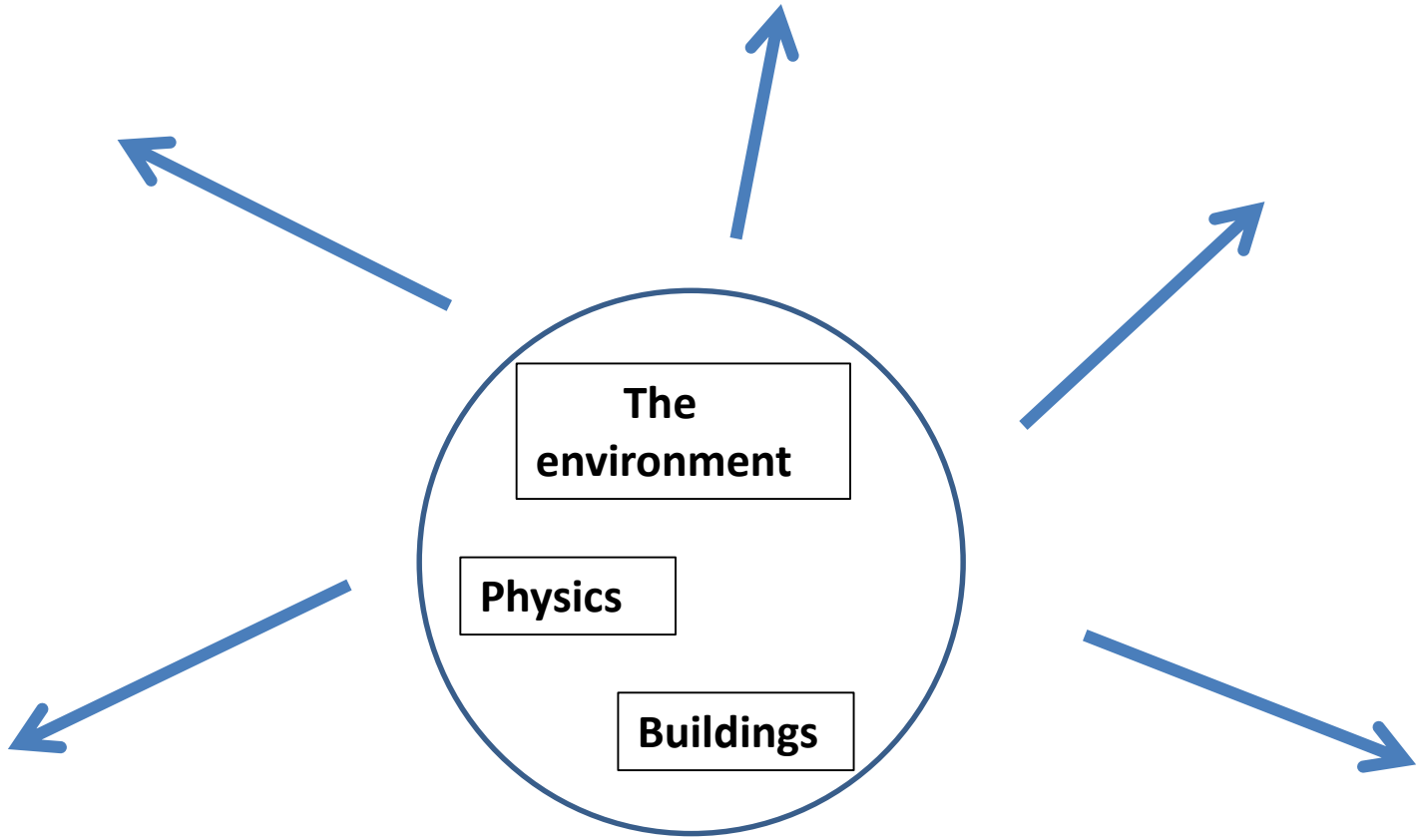
