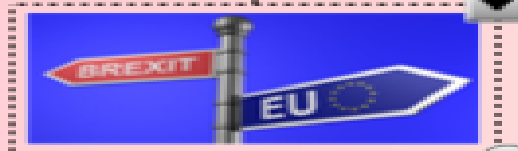
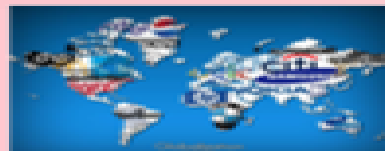


Is this the right subject
