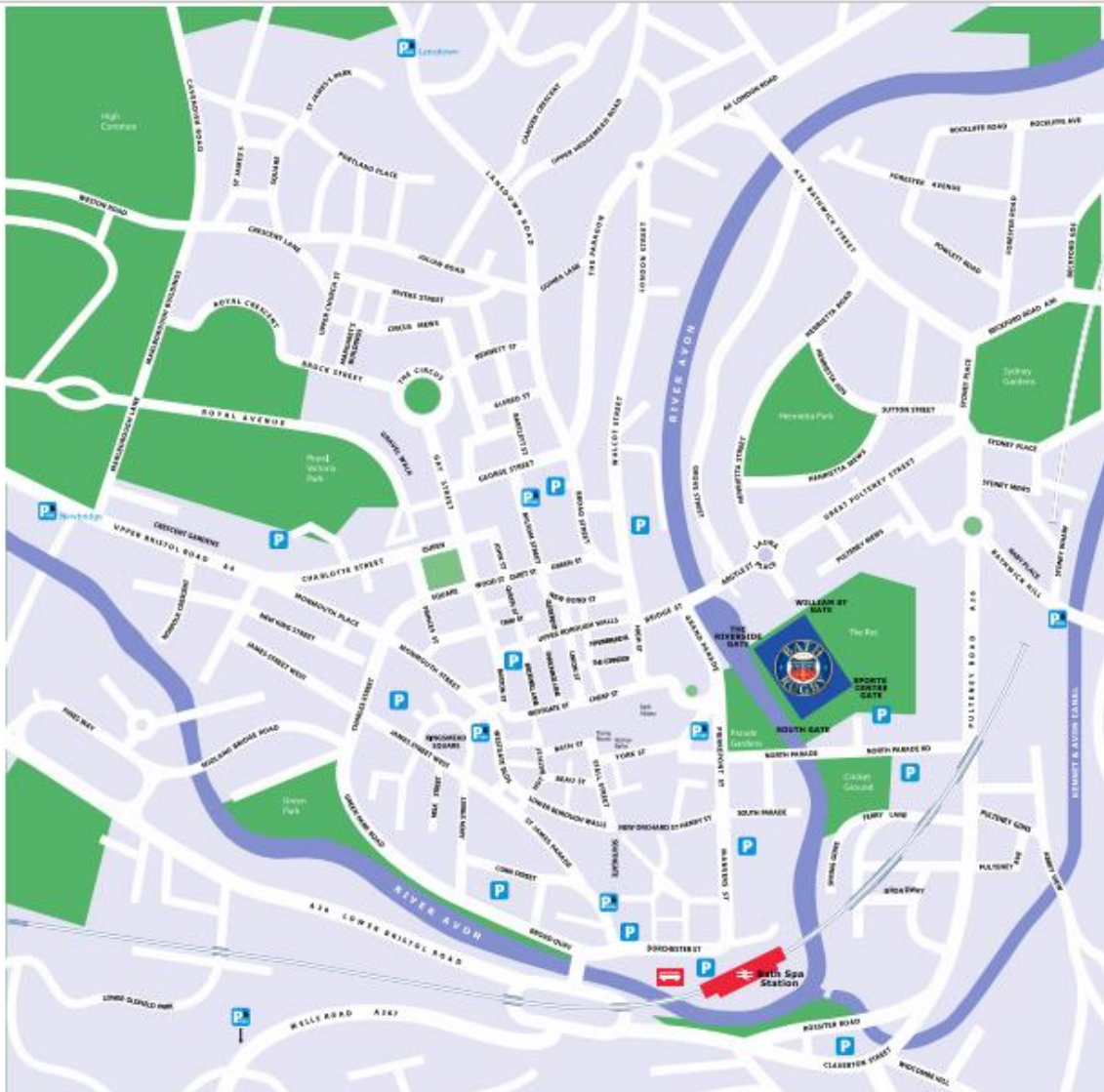

Bath Rec Sports Hub, North Parade Road, Bath, BA2 4ET



WALK: It's a short stroll from numerous city car parks, Park & Ride drop-off points, the train station, and the town centre.

TRAIN: Bristol Temple Meads – Bath Spa (15 mins). Once you reach the station The Rec is a five-minute walk. Follow the riverside path to the rear of the station straight to the ground.

BUS: Bristol X39, Lansdown 4 or 31, Corsham X31, Twerton 21, Bathampton D1

Alternatively, why not cycle down to the Rec? Free, secure parking spaces for bikes are offered just next to William Street Gate.
