Canada Sport Tour 2026 – Netball and Rugby

After the success of the sports tour to Sri Lanka this summer the PE Department is in the process of launching the Malmesbury School 2026 Canada Sports Tour. The trip will run in the summer term of 2026 with a 10-day itinerary staying in both Toronto and Ottawa. The current itinerary includes two fixtures for each netball and rugby team against local teams or schools that have been organised by our tour company, England Rugby Travel.

Students will also have the opportunity to experience Canadian culture and history in Toronto and Ottawa. There will also be a number of thrill-seeking experiences including white-water rafting and an overnight camp in the Canadian wilderness and a boat trip to Niagara Falls. These will give the students a breadth of lifetime experiences, the opportunity to represent their school in a foreign country and create a highlight of their time with us at Malmesbury School.

A provisional itinerary for the trip is attached at the end of the letter. Please note, this itinerary is subject to change.

Date: July 2026 - Exact dates are to be confirmed.

Location: Canada – Toronto and Ottawa.

Cost: Approximately £3,200.00. Subject to change due to prices for flights and coaches not yet released for 2026. This cost includes – International airfare, coach transfers throughout the trip, breakfast and dinner, 8 lunches costed at £10 each, all fixtures and excursions. Any money for other items such as souvenirs and extra food and drink is not included in this price.


Travel: Coach transfers to and from the airport in the UK and Canada. Coach transfers will also be provided to and from fixtures and excursions.

Accommodation: University Halls whilst in the two cities.

Extra Information: Upon arrival an England Sports Tour representative will meet the tour party and will assist us during key points in the tour. All representatives are fully trained to ensure the trip is as enjoyable and stress free as possible. There will be five members of Malmesbury School staff attending the trip.

Medical:

It is the parents/carers responsibility to advise school immediately upon booking a trip of any pre-existing medical conditions and update school with any subsequent changes to ensure your child's medical condition is fully covered by our insurance provider, also teachers accompanying the trip require up to date medical information. Failure to notify school of any pre-existing or new medical conditions may result in students not being insured. It is the parent's/carer's responsibility to ensure that your child carries their emergency medication on the trip including inhalers/EpiPen's. Failure to do so will result in non-attendance of the trip.

Vaccinations:

Please look at recommended inoculations required for travel to Canada and contact your medical practitioner or doctor's surgery for any vaccination requirements.

Consent:

If you would like your child to attend, please give your permission via ParentPay by 6th January 2025.

Size of Group:

Spaces are limited to 50 students; if the trip is oversubscribed, names will be randomly selected after the deadline.

Please note that we reserve the right to exclude students from going on a trip when their general behaviour in lessons and around school has been persistently below the standard we expect and when a student would be seen as risk to their personal safety or that of others.

Criteria for trip:

Students must be regularly attending the school club for rugby or netball in which they intend to participate on the tour.

Overall behaviour must be above 70% with discretion of school on each case.

Attitude to learning in core and exam-based PE (if applicable) must uphold Malmesbury school standards.

It must be noted that this trip is for students who are committed to attending Malmesbury sixth form and is only for students at the school. If your child leaves Malmesbury School after their GCSEs and takes a place at another provider for whatever reason, they will be unable to attend the trip or receive a refund.


Once students have committed to the trip all payments are non refundable as stipulated by England Sports Tours.

Payments will be required as follows:-

£600.00	Due by 28 th February 2025
£400.00	Due by 30 th April 2025
£400.00	Due by 30 th June 2025
£400.00	Due by 31 st August 2025
£400.00	Due by 31 st October 2025
£400.00	Due by 31 st December 2025
£400.00	Due by 28 th February 2026

The remaining balance will be due by 30th April.





If you agree to your child participating in the trip as detailed above and would like your child to attend, please log on to ParentPay to add medical and other requested information, confirm your consent by **Monday 6th January 2025.**

Once this has been done, we will select the 50 students for the trip and from here payment will be able to be made on ParentPay.

DAY 1: LONDON / TORONTO

Arrive at London Heathrow Airport (tbc) where you will be met by an England Sports Tours representative who will oversee check in for your flight to Toronto.

On arrival you will be met by an England Sports Tours representative and transferred to the University of Toronto Residences for a four-night stay on half board basis (breakfast and dinner).

After checking in you will spend the afternoon exploring your new surroundings.

Return to your accommodation this evening for an evening at leisure.

DAY 8: OTTAWA


