Applications to College, Sixth Forms and Apprenticeships - Year 11

How and when to apply?

Whilst most colleges do not have a set application deadline, the preference is for applications to be made as early as possible in year 11 (ideally before the Christmas break) to allow for interviews to take place before Easter.

Year 11 students can apply to as many colleges and sixth forms as they wish and make a final decision after GCSE results if needs be.

Students who wish to apply to a sixth form need to check with the sixth form directly to find out when they will be accepting applications. Most sixth forms will have an application window that opens after their open day has taken place.

Open days for Colleges and Sixth Forms will usually be held this term – most of them will require you to book a space (see attached ‘College Open Days 2025-2026’ document with details of many local events and how to book them). Please do book on to the events as soon as possible, ideally students will visit a few places to compare their options.

Year 11 and Year 13 students will be given priority for careers meetings this term, students can request an appointment via their tutor or by contacting Sarah Griffin at: sgriffin@malmesbury.wilts.sch.uk Sarah is based in the counselling room on the lower Street Tuesday to Friday.



Apprenticeships information for year 11, and 13

Year 11 Students wishing to apply for apprenticeships who do not have an employer should follow these steps:

- 1) Apply to colleges/training providers before Christmas. Colleges/training providers will try to match apprentices with employers. However, it's always best to seek your own employer. Colleges locally providing apprenticeships include: **Cirencester, Bath, Wiltshire, South Gloucestershire & Stroud and New College Swindon.**
- 2) Create an account and set up vacancy alerts on: [Find an apprenticeship - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/find-an-apprenticeship)
Most vacancies for year 11 leavers will be advertised from Spring – however some larger firms will recruit from the Autumn term.
- 3) Contact local businesses of interest sending a CV and a speculative letter – you might get in touch with them just before they advertise!

For those students with an employer lined up, their employer should be able to direct them to the appropriate college or training provider to apply to. However, if the employer isn't sure, please speak to Sarah Griffin – careers adviser for advice.

Year 13 Students wishing to apply for apprenticeships should follow these steps:

- 1) Create an account and set up vacancy alerts on: [Find an apprenticeship - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/find-an-apprenticeship) Apprenticeships can be advertised at any point in the year but many vacancies for year 13 leavers will be advertised from the Autumn term
- 2) Register for alerts and search on UCAS via: [Search apprenticeships | UCAS](https://www.ucas.com/apprenticeships) Some higher and degree apprenticeships will also be advertised via: [NGTU | Job Search \(notgoingtouni.co.uk\)](https://notgoingtouni.co.uk/)
- 3) Consider your back up plan – if you're not successful finding an apprenticeship this year – what else could you do? A Gap year, an entry level job, go to university? Many students apply for apprenticeships and to UCAS for a degree keeping more options open for longer.

Virtual Work experience

NHS Allied Health Professions (AHP) programme - several sessions of work experience before the UCAS deadline for NHS Health Careers in January. (NOT FREE, £10.00 a session)

Once registered, students will be emailed links to their virtual work experience portals.

Students are awarded a Work Experience Certificate for every session they complete. Those who complete the full 5 month programme will be awarded a Highly Commended Reference from the Presidents of Allied Healthcare Mentor. These are fantastic additions to their CVs and UCAS applications!

This programme is suitable for students in years 10 – 13 who are interested in the following careers:

- Nursing
- Midwifery
- Paramedicine
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Dietetics
- Radiography
- Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Pharmacy

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. They will gain a unique insight into how patients interact with a variety of healthcare professionals and what it's like to work in an NHS multidisciplinary team.

Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with healthcare professionals throughout each day. This will empower students to make an informed career decision and demonstrate their commitment to healthcare in their UCAS applications.

Students can register individually at any time throughout the 5-month programme using the link below. We recommend booking early to gain as much out of this programme as possible. Places are £10 a session to cover administrative and technological costs.


Sarah is in school Tuesdays to Fridays and a drop-in service is available at lunch times.
